



FOLLOW YOUR NOSE

Objective:

Demonstrate how animals use their sense of smell to navigate what is good and what is bad in their environment

Supplies Needed:

6 small cups

Variety of Scents (eg. Cinnamon, Perfume, Apple Cider Vinegar, Garlic, Cocoa Powder)

1 Sheet of paper

Blind fold

Instructions:

Step 1. Place a portion of each scent in each one of the cups

Step 2. Cut little pieces of paper and place it on top of the cups to keep the smell inside the cups, and to keep students from seeing what the scent is

Step 3. Apply the blind fold on the student to smell the scent and guess what it is

LESSON:

How animals use their sense of smell to help them navigate what is a good smell and what is a bad smell around their environment.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

6 small cups
Cinnamon
Perfume
Apple Cider Vinegar
Garlic
Cocoa Powder
Onion
1 sheet of paper
Blind fold

INSTRUCTIONS:

- Step 1. Pour a tiny bit of cinnamon in a one of the cups
- Step 2. Pour apple cider vinegar in one cup
- Step 3. Spray one pump of perfume in one cup
- Step 4. Slice a tiny piece of onion and place it in one cup
- Step 5. Pour a tiny bit of cocoa powder in one cup
- Step 6. Chop a tiny piece of garlic and place it in one cup.
- Step 7. Cut little pieces of paper and place it on top of the cups to keep the smell inside the cups, and to keep from seeing what the scent is.
- Step 8. Apply the blind fold on the student to smell the scent and guess what it is.
