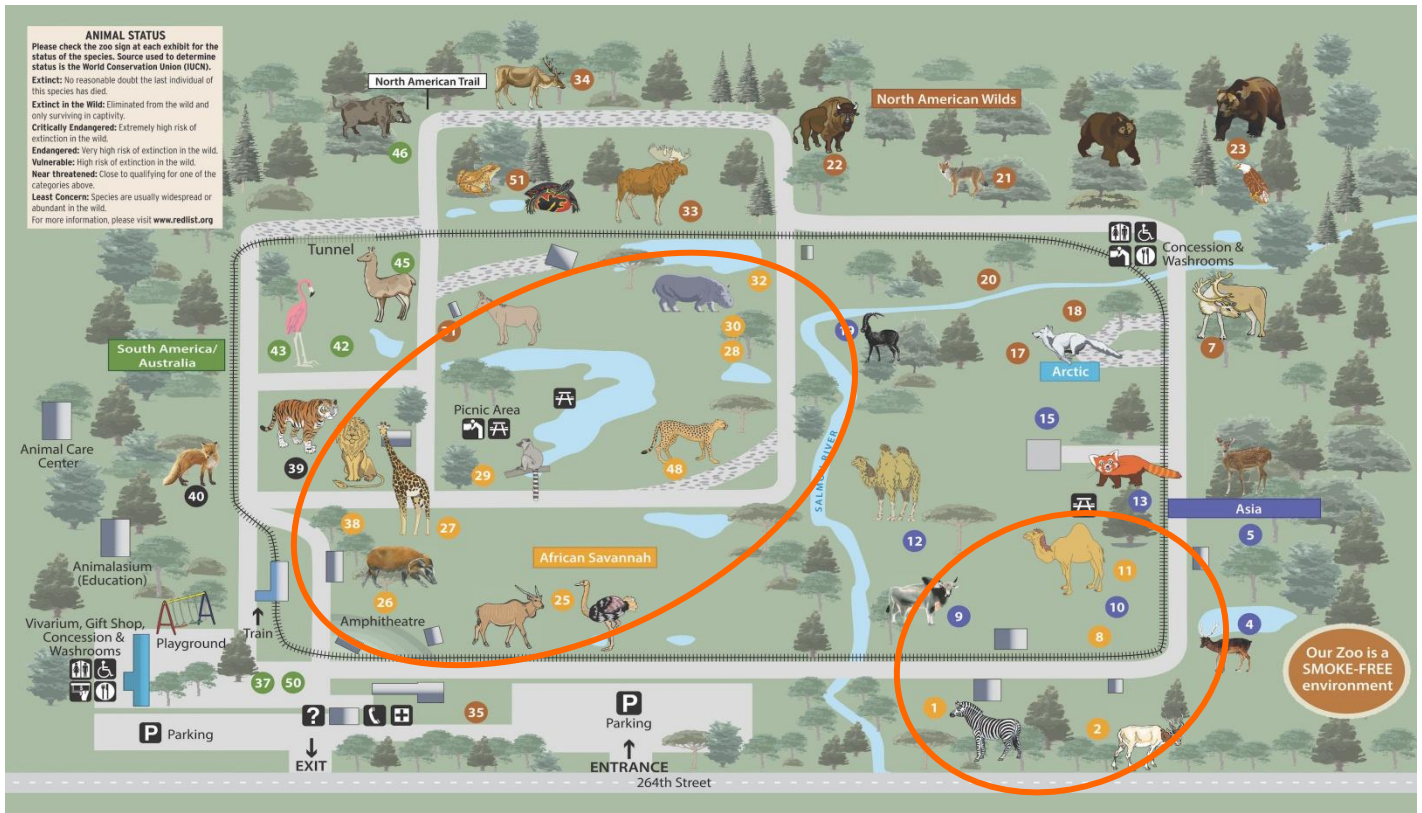


Scavenger Hunt: African Savannah Route
